Cleveland Print Room invites you to explore analog photography with our Camera Share Program pilot. Using equipment donated to CPR, each participant will receive a film camera with one roll of color and one roll of black-and-white film (unless alternative arrangements are made). CPR will handle film development as well as the scanning, archiving, and sharing of the negatives. Your work could be featured on any number of CPR platforms or printed materials.

Our current project, a property inventory, centers the built environment. Through this project we have invited participants and prospective viewers into a dialogue about observation and place. In this program, we encourage you to investigate your surroundings and how they can shape your point of view. This should be reflected in what you create as a participant in this camera sharing experience.

Film Development: Return your film for professional processing and scanning.

Digital Scans: Negatives will be scanned, archived, and shared.

Feedback: Share your experience to help us enhance the program.
